Research shows that invitation works best when churches have:

a high value of prayer

spend time in small groups

have growing interest in unchurched persons

Invitation needs a growth system, a plan... networking.

Pastors must lead the way on invitation in their churches.

Networking is a lifestyle for those who follow Christ.

#### I. What it means for pastors to get out into the mission field:

The attraction model ...

Attraction is an old wineskin! Attraction may have worked in 1955

In 2011, less than 20% attend church

In the 21st Century, Invitation is the way to reach new people because it's relational and authentic.

Invitation is the new wineskin.

Every church casts a shadow.

When pastors exist the church building, they are extending the church's shadow.

The ratio of yeses to your invites is about 1 in ten or 15

Invitation requires thicker skin.

God is working through us to invite.

invitation is in context.

#### II. Specific steps the pastor takes to get out into the mission field.

Every church has a mission field, first by virtue of their location.

Urban areas:

Rural areas.

Geography is only one mission field factor. others including affinity

We can also connect around personal redemption.

PAUSE FOR A PERSONAL STORY OF INVITATION

Ask God to open the doorway to spiritual conversations.

Seize opportunities to talk about faith. it takes practice, and surrender.

Prayer comes easily with those already in our churches. What about those with whom we're less acquainted? When was the last time i:

Offered to pray for someone who isn't a churchgoer

Spoke into that person's life

Prepared to answer objections about Christianity

Prayed for that person's heart to open to God

Invited that person to my church?

SPENDING TIME WITH GOD, ASKING GOD TO BE INVOLVED IN INVITATION, SPENDING TIME WITH THE MISSION FIELD form the NUCLEUS of the pastor's forays into the mission field. Prayer creates the opportunity for invitation; Calendaring creates the system

Some things you can do to get out into the mission field.

Hold office hours in a coffee shop

Join Rotary and become the chaplain

Do ride alongs

Partner with community service organizations

Go to the gym

Press in on your prayers

Pray for specific people

Seize opportunities to talk about faith

Gather personal intercessors

Tell your congregation

This plan represents 25% of your regular workweek.
